Create a new worksheet. Click on the Data tab and then click on Consolidate. In the Function section, choose Sum. How to Combine and Merge Data from Multiple Worksheets

It is important to realize that at this point each of the new worksheets contains a small PivotTable. To get rid of these PivotTables, you might think that you can create a selection set of the new worksheets (click the first worksheet tab and then hold down the Shift key as you click the last worksheet tab) and then press the Delete key.

Creating Worksheets from a List of Names (Microsoft Excel)

CREATE THE PIVOT TABLE. This next step is counterintuitive because most people start a pivot table by selecting the data that they want to appear in the pivot table. But for our purposes, you need to insert a blank worksheet in your workbook or simply start from a blank cell on Sheet1 and go to Insert, PivotTable.

This approach is a best practice when working with multiple open workbooks. In Step 2, you use the Add method of the Workbook object to create a workbook. The blank workbook is equivalent to manually choosing File→New→Blank Document in the Excel ribbon. In Step 3, you use the Paste method to send the copied data to cell A1 of the new workbook.
