This preserved turtle specimen has vessels that are double injected with red and blue latex. The shell of this turtle specimen is precut. Typically genus Tachemys.. Note: Specimens are initially preserved with a formaldehyde solution, the best animal tissue fixative. The formaldehyde is then displaced first with water and finally with a glycol solution to produce a moist, low-fume specimen ...
